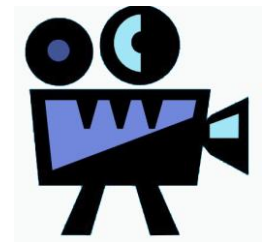
Alejandra García is Centre Exams Manager and Director at [International House Querétaro](#).
