The new rules give students who want to study in Australia the opportunity to use this high quality, secure international qualification to prove that they have the language skills they need for academic success. [Cambridge English: Advanced](#) complements IELTS, which is well established as a test of English for immigration to Australia, and which is also produced by Cambridge ESOL.
