IELTS attracted over 938,000 candidates in 2007. Entries for IELTS have almost doubled in the last three years, driven by university entrance requirements, new immigration policies and professional recognition throughout the English-speaking world. IELTS is now used by over 6,000 organisations worldwide, with recognition in the US now topping 1,300 institutions. The test is taken every year across 120 countries, and is one of the fastest growing English language tests in the world, and sets the standard in integrity, research and innovation. Examination Results for all examinations taken in the November/December session are already available.
